 - (ii) the company satisfied the conditions for exemption from an audit of the accounts for the year specified in section 249A(4) of the Act and did not, at any time within the year, fall within any of the categories of companies not entitled to the exemption specified in section 249B(1)."

NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS

at 31 July 1995

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparation of financial statements

The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and include the results of the company's operations which are described in the Directors' Report and all of which are continuing.

The accounts are prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards.

The company has taken advantage of the exemption in Financial Reporting Standard Number 1, from the requirement to prepare a cash flow statement on the grounds that it is a small company.

Turnover

Turnover, which is stated net of value added tax, represents goods and services supplied, less returns and allowances.

Depreciation

Depreciation is charged at rates calculated to write off the cost, less estimated residual value, of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows:

Freehold land

Nil

Freehold buildings

2% per annum, straight line

Plant and equipment

20% per annum, reducing balance

Motor vehicles

25% per annum, reducing balance 15% per annum, reducing balance

Office equipment Moulds

Over 3 years, straight line

Stocks

Stocks are stated at the lower of cost or net realisable value, as follows:

Raw materials

Purchase cost

Goods for resale

Purchase cost

Work in progress

Cost of direct materials and labour, plus attributable overheads, based on a

normal level of activity.

Net realisable value is based on estimated selling price, less any further costs expected to be incurred to completion and disposal.

Deferred taxation

Deferred taxation is provided on the liability method on all timing differences to the extent that they are expected to reverse in the future without being replaced, calculated at the rate at which it is estimated that tax will be payable.

Pensions

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme and the pension charge represents the amounts payable by the company to the fund in respect of the year.
