b) Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Companies Act 2006, and with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015) and the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102).
