#### 1 Introduction and Statutory Information

- 1.1 I, Lisa Jane Hogg, together with my partner Emma Bower, of Wilson Field Limited, The Manor House, 260 Ecclesall Road South, Sheffield, S11 9PS, was appointed as Joint Liquidator of Purseworld Leathergoods Limited (the Company) on 27 June 2018. This report provides an update on the progress in the liquidation for year ended 26 June 2019 (the Period).
- 1.2 Information about the way that we will use, and store personal data on insolvency appointments can be found at "https://www.wilsonfield.co.uk/not-so-small-print/". If you are unable to download this, please contact us and a hard copy will be provided to you.
- 1.3 The trading address of the Company was 360 Moorside Road, Swinton, Manchester, M27 9PW.
- 1.4 The registered office of the Company was changed to Wilson Field Limited, The Manor House, 260 Ecclesall Road South, Sheffield, S11 9PS and its registered number is 02759152.

#### 2 Progress of the Liquidation

2.1 At Appendix A, I have provided an account of my Receipts and Payments for the Period, with a comparison to the Declaration of Solvency values. The reason that the liquidation has not been completed within the first 12 months is due to HM Revenue & Customs ("HMRC") having submitted an unanticipated claim in the liquidation. The directors disputed this claim and various exchanges have been held with HMRC to establish whether the tax claimed was actually due. It subsequently transpired that the claim was incorrect and HMRC have now granted full clearance for the case to be closed.

#### 2.2 Tax Refund

2.3 As outlined above, HMRC submitted a claim in the liquidation in respect of unpaid corporation tax. HMRC were of the opinion that a tax refund of £66,341.82 had been issued to the Company in June 2018; however, the cheque was never received or cashed. Once HMRC updated their systems in respect of the credit balance still held in the corporation tax account, this balance was reallocated to settle HMRC's claim and a refund of the surplus of £4,046.65 was issued.

#### 2.4 Insurance Refund/Claim

2.5 An insurance refund in the sum of £1,264.10 was received from BNL on the 13<sup>th</sup> of September 2018. This relates to the premium due back to the Company from the sale of the warehouse property.

#### 2.6 Cash at Bank

2.7 The credit balance on the Company bank account was received on the 15<sup>th</sup> of October 2018 totalling £392,351.16.

#### 2.8 Business Rates Refund

2.9 A refund of £2,072.63 was received from Salford City Council on the 10<sup>th</sup> of August 2018 for business rates.

#### 2.10 Utility Refund

2.11 Two utility refunds have been received; being £194.24 from Npower Ltd and £1,719.65 from British Gas.

#### 3 Distributions to Members

- 3.1 The following cash distributions to members have been made since the date of my appointment:
  - An interim dividend of £323.74 per ordinary share on 27 November 2018
  - A final dividend of £250 per ordinary share on 5 June 2019

#### 4 Joint Liquidators' Remuneration

4.1 The members approved that the basis of the Liquidators' remuneration be fixed as a set amount of £1,695 plus VAT plus disbursements.

I can advise that since my appointment, I have drawn £1,695 plus disbursements of £636.50 for the period to the date of this report.

- 4.2 The Liquidators have drawn the total set fee as approved by the members.

#### Appendix B

#### Additional Information in Relation to Joint Liquidators' Fees

#### 1 Staff allocation and the use of subcontractors

- 1.1 The general approach to resourcing our assignments is to allocate staff with the skills and experience to meet the specific requirements of the case.
- 1.2 The constitution of the case team will usually consist of a Partner, a Manager, and an Administrator or Assistant. The exact constitution of the case team will depend on the anticipated size and complexity of the assignment and the experience requirements of the assignment.
- 1.3 We are not proposing to utilise the services of any sub-contractors in this case.

#### 2 Joint Liquidators' Disbursements

- 2.1 Category 1 disbursements do not require approval by members.
