# BODY BRONZE LTD - COMPANY VOLUNTARY ARRANGEMENT ("CVA")

The Supervisor presents his fourth annual report upon the progress of this Voluntary Arrangement. This report should be read in conjunction with the CVA Proposal at the meeting of creditors held on 13 May 2013 and previous annual reports.

## 1. RECEIPTS AND PAYMENTS ACCOUNT

I attach an account of receipts and payments for the current period 13 May 2016 to 12 May 2017 and cumulatively from the commencement of the Arrangement to the end of the anniversary.

### 2. TERMS OF THE ARRANGEMENT

Under the terms of the Arrangement the Company is to make monthly contributions totalling £45,000.00, over a 5 year period, of which £36,030.00 has been received.

The Company is also to make a lump sum contribution totalling £1,000.00 during the course of the Arrangement, which has been received.

Unsecured creditors will receive a dividend of approximately 43.3 pence in the  $\mathfrak L$  in full and final settlement of their debt.

## 3. SUPERVISORS' REPORT AND COMMENTS

The Company is up to date in respect of monthly contributions as at the anniversary date.

Statutory returns and the returns for HM Revenue & Customs ("HMRC") have been completed as and when due.

Based on performance to date, it is anticipated that the CVA will be successfully implemented, as set out in the CVA Proposal. The CVA has a further one year to run. If the Company continues to pay the required contributions and the costs are in line with those originally estimated, it is anticipated that the total dividend to be paid to unsecured creditors will reach the estimated dividend of 43.3 in the £.

### 4. CREDITORS' CLAIMS AND DIVIDEND PROSPECTS

Preferential claims in respect of employee arrears of pay and holiday pay were estimated in the Statement of Affairs at £3,500.00. The preferential claims submitted in the CVA amounted to £794.04 and a distribution to preferential creditors of 100p in the £ was declared on 17 September 2015.



The dividend prospects as set out in the CVA Proposal were based on the unsecured creditors' claims estimated at that time totalling £66,779.86 as below. Although the total claims received to date are less than the total listed in the CVA Proposal, it should be noted that additional claims may be received in response to the dividend notice.

Ordinary unsecured claims have been received from twelve creditors amounting to £64,111.17; of this eleven creditors totalling £63,979.79 have been agreed. The director's Statement of Affairs highlighted seventeen creditors with estimated unsecured claims of £66,779.86. It should be noted that four of the claims received are additional claims which were not highlighted in the proposal.

The following creditors are requested to submit their claims:

BCW Group Ltd/Eon Energy Solutions - claim form and supporting evidence.

British Telecom (BT) plc - claim form and supporting evidence.

Chubb - claim form and supporting evidence.

Fuel Card Services Limited - claim form and supporting evidence.

GPUK LLP t/a Global Payments - supporting evidence.

HSBC Bank plc (Overdraft) - claim form and supporting evidence.

HSCB Bank plc (Credit Card) - claim form and supporting evidence.

Phoenix Commercial Collections - claim form and supporting evidence.

Sage (UK) Limited (TAS Software) - claim form and supporting evidence.

T Mobile - claim form and supporting evidence.

Dividends totalling 19.91 pence in the £ have been paid to unsecured creditors to date.

After providing for costs of the CVA to date, including Nominees and Supervisors fees, there are sufficient funds available to pay a third dividend to creditors. It is anticipated that a dividend will be paid to creditors within two months from the date of proving being 28 July 2017.

A dividend notice is enclosed requesting claims to be submitted by 28 July 2017. If your name is listed above, please provide the information requested, to be included in the dividend distribution. A creditor claim form is available on the portal, if required.

# 5. REMUNERATION & DISBURSEMENTS

Nominees' fees of £5,000.00 were approved at the first meeting of creditors held on 13 May 2013, which have been drawn.

The Supervisors remuneration is based on hourly costs at scale rates calculated on the time properly spent in the course of the CVA and was approved at the meeting of creditors to consider the CVA proposal held on 13 May 2013.

In the current period the Supervisor has incurred time costs of £2,941.25 representing 17.00 hours at an average hourly charge-out rate of £173.01. Total time spent to 12 May 2017 on this assignment amounts to 123.99 hours at an average composite rate of £167.39 per hour resulting in total time costs to date of £20,754.75. Supervisors fees of £10,000.00 have been drawn to date in accordance with the above approval leaving outstanding time costs of £10,754.75.

The time costs were incurred in carrying out a number of tasks during the course of the CVA. The attached breakdown shows that a significant portion of the time costs incurred relate to Administration and Planning, and Statutory & Compliance, as well as Floating Charge



Assets/Contributions, which in the main relates to undertaking statutory duties and chasing the monthly contributions due from the director. Whilst these tasks have not had a direct benefit in enhancing realisations for the creditors, they have assisted in the efficient and compliant progressing of the administration of the case, which has ensured that the Supervisor and his staff have carried out their work to high professional standards. In addition, the time spent supervising the Company's compliance with the CVA terms has increased the likelihood that the CVA will be implemented successfully.

In addition, the Supervisor is required to comply with statutory and regulatory duties as regards filing, maintaining records, managing a cash book and bank account, monitoring and processing the Company's payments of voluntary contributions, conducting periodic case reviews, preparing annual reports and pursuing delivery of the Company's trading accounts and carrying out a review of them.

Significant time has also been spent in dealing with creditors' claims and particularly in assisting employees with their claims as well as adjudicating on claims for dividend purposes, which has required the Supervisor to seek additional information from creditors and the Company. Although this work has no direct financial benefit to creditors, it is the Supervisors duty to ensure that dividends are correctly paid to creditors in line with their statutory entitlements.

The CVA Proposal disclosed that the Supervisors' fees for administering and completing the CVA were estimated to be £6,000.00. In view of the time costs incurred to date and the anticipated work to conclude the CVA, the final time costs of the Supervisor will be higher than originally estimated due to the difficulties encountered and the additional work carried out, as described above.

Therefore time costs of £10,000.00 will be written off by the Supervisor, leaving outstanding time costs of £754.75.

Disbursements of £968.48 have been allocated to the case up to the anniversary of which £924.89 have been drawn by the Supervisors leaving unbilled disbursements of £43.59.

All other payments have been made in accordance with the rules and regulations generally as to the payment of costs and expenses in the Arrangement.

# 6. CONCLUSION

The CVA is progressing as anticipated and the Supervisor will continue to monitor the Company's adherence to its terms, taking appropriate steps in line with the CVA terms where necessary. Provided that the CVA continues to progress as planned, the Supervisor will issue a further progress report shortly after the next anniversary of the CVA.

A third dividend will be paid to creditors within two months from the date of proving being 28 July 2017.
