Registration

ZincOx Resources (USA) Limited is a limited company registered in England and Wales with registered number 05787260.

Directors' Responsibilities for the Financial Statements

The directors are responsible for preparing the Directors' Report and financial statements in accordance with applicable law and regulations.

Company law requires the directors to prepare financial statements for each financial year which give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the Company as at the end of the financial year and of the profit or loss of the Company for the financial year. Under that law the directors have elected to prepare financial statements in accordance with United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice). In preparing these financial statements, the directors are required to:

- select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently,
- make judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent,
- state whether applicable UK Accounting standards have been followed in the Company's financial statements, subject to any material departures disclosed and explained in the financial statements, and
- prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the Company will continue in business.

The directors are responsible for keeping adequate accounting records that are sufficient to show and explain the Company's transactions and disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the Company and to enable them to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Companies Act 2006. They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the Company and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities. The directors confirm that:

- so far as each director is aware, there is no relevant audit information of which the Company's auditor is unaware, and

Business Review

The results for the year and financial position of the Company are as shown in the annexed financial statements. Given that the Company is no longer in operation, with all inter-group loans forgiven in 2016, the directors hope to wind it up in the forthcoming year. There have been no events since the balance sheet date which materially affect the position of the Company.

Results and Dividends

The Company's loss for the year is \$1,541,000 (2015: \$1,964,000). The directors propose that no dividend will be paid for the year.

Financial Risk Management

The directors' financial risk management objective is to maximise financial assets and minimise financial liabilities whilst not engaging in speculation. The financial risks faced by the Company include:

- · foreign currency fluctuations, and
- liquidity of investments

The directors manage each of the above mentioned financial risks as follows:

- continually review short term investments to ensure that maximum rates are being achieved.
- hold cash and short-term investments in the currencies of anticipated expenditure, and
- actively review and approve the terms of and parties to significant commercial contracts where payment is not expended in advance

Auditors

1. General Information

ZincOx Resources (USA) Limited is a private limited company (registered number 05787260), which is incorporated in the UK. The address of the registered office is Crown House, High Street, Hartley Wintney, Hampshire, RG27 8NW.

2. Principal Accounting Policies

(a) Basis of Preparation

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with applicable United Kingdom accounting standards, including Financial Reporting Standard 102 – 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the United Kingdom and Republic of Ireland' ('FRS 102'), and with the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared on the historical cost basis except for the modification to a fair value basis for certain financial instruments as specified in the accounting policies below.

The financial statements are presented in US Dollars (\$).

The individual accounts of FRS 102 Limited have also adopted the following disclosure exemptions:

- the requirement to present a statement of cash flows and related notes
- financial instrument disclosures, including:
 - categories of financial instruments,
 - items of income, expenses, gains or losses relating to financial instruments, and
 - exposure to and management of financial risks

The Company is exempt from preparing consolidated financial statements on the grounds it is a wholly owned subsidiary of ZincOx Resources plc. The financial statements therefore present information about the Company as an individual undertaking and not about its group.

The principal accounting policies of the Company are set out below.

(b) Foreign Currency

Transactions in foreign currencies are translated at the exchange rate ruling at the date of the transaction. Monetary assets and liabilities in foreign currencies are translated at the rates of exchange ruling at the balance sheet date. Any gain or loss arising from a change in exchange rates subsequent to the date of the transaction is included as an exchange gain or loss in the profit and loss account.

The presentational currency of the Company is US Dollars. An exchange rate of 1.23016 (2015: 1.48236) has been used to convert Sterling to US Dollars at the Balance Sheet date. An average monthly exchange rate for the period of 1.36548 (2015: 1.53234) has been used to convert Sterling to US Dollars in the Profit and Loss Account.

(c) Investments

Investments are included at cost less provisions for impairment in value.

(d) Critical Accounting Estimates and Judgements

Under FRS 102, the Company has imputed a market rate of interest on its receivable balance held with its subsidiaries. However, as the USA is no longer being considered for the development of a Zinc recycling plant, the directors have taken the decision to fully impair its receivable with its subsidiary company and has now formally forgiven the debt at the end of the year.

Furthermore, a decision was made by the parent company, to formally forgive its loan to the Company, resulting in a capital contribution in the year of \$53,852,000.

(e) Going Concern

With the Company now dormant, with no net assets, the directors may decide to liquidate the Company. The directors consider that there is no difference between the going concern basis and cessation basis, and therefore there are no adjustments to consider in the preparation of these financial statements.

3. Turnover and profit /(loss) on ordinary activities before taxation

The profit / (loss) on ordinary activities before taxation is attributable to the principal activity of the Company.

The Company's audit fees are borne by the parent company.

4. Directors and Employees

No director received any remuneration from the Company and there are no other employees of the Company.
