2 Introduction

- This report provides a summary of the outcome of the liquidation of Reclaim Resources Limited (the 'Company') At Appendix A, I have provided an account of my receipts and payments for the period of my appointment
- I was appointed as Liquidator of the Company on 8 June 2011 by the Secretary of State following a Winding up Order made on 27 May 2011

3 Realisation of Assets

Cash at Bank

As previously confirmed as at the date of my appointment the Company's bank account with HSBC Bank Plc held a credit balance of £24,371 44 I can confirm that this was received into the liquidation in full

Plant & Machinery and Intellectual Property

- Upon my appointment as Liquidator I was approached by Mr Hall who expressed a wish to purchase the Company's assets. It was my understanding from the Official Receiver that following the winding up order he had received no interest from any additional third parties regarding the assets. A seven day exclusivity period was entered into between myself and Mr Hall following my appointment which resulted in an immediate payment of a non refundable deposit in the sum of £100,000.
- As previously stated, although the exclusivity agreement was between myself and Mr Hall I can confirm that the non refundable deposit was not paid by Mr Hall personally but by a third party Prior to the expiry of the exclusivity period I was contacted by two further parties who expressed an interest in the assets, however neither party were able to provide me with evidence of funding nor did they make an offer either before or after the exclusivity period. The initial potential purchaser was also threatening to withdraw his offer after the exclusivity period had expired if a sale was not agreed, leaving myself with one genuine offer which was therefore duly accepted in the sum of £250,000 (inclusive of the non refundable deposit)
- I can advise the purchaser was Regional Property Group (RPG) a British Virgin Isles company which was unconnected to Mr Hall. The sale proceeds were apportioned as follows

The only further realisation to occur within the period of this report is bank interest net of tax in the sum of £1,733 92, interest received from solicitors in the sum of £29 72 and a sundry receipt from the Insolvency Service in the sum of £14 10

4 Investigations

- I am required to investigate the affairs of the Company and conduct of the Directors in the period leading up to the winding up order Findings are reported via The Insolvency Service to the Department of Business Innovation & Skills in accordance with the Company's Directors Disqualification Act 1986
- As previously stated in my last report my investigations into the Company's affairs resulted in locating a number of payments which constituted property dispositions pursuant to S127 of the Insolvency Act 1986. I am pleased to report that the total sum of £74,082.26 has been recovered in respect of these payments.
- As stated previously I conducted a full review of the Company's books and records with the assistance of Mr Hall and his previous professional advisors

- Concerns were raised by creditors regarding the utilisation of monies invested into the Company given its extremely short trading period. As previously confirmed legal proceedings had been commenced against the Director and his wife ("the Respondents") regarding various transactions prior to the winding up of the company and a five day trial had been convened to commence 6 July 2015.
- Following mediation between both parties a financial settlement had been agreed against both Respondents and respective legal advisors on 16 June 2015 as follows

Either

1 That the Respondents pay to myself on or before 15 June 2016 the sum of £125,000 provided that £15,000 of that sum be paid to myself before 7 July 2015

- 2 That the Respondents pay to myself on or before 15 June 2016 the sum of £150,000
- Both options were to be supported by the Respondents granting myself a charge over their matrimonial home by way of security
- As previously confirmed in my last report to creditors the Respondents have now paid the sum of £125,000 in full as reflected in the attached Receipts and Payments account

Unsecured Creditors

As per the Statement of Affairs prepared by the Company's Director at the date of liquidation there were unsecured creditors totalling £3,323,930 06. I can advise that I have received claims totalling £3,382,852.95 in this respect. Unfortunately, there have been insufficient realisations to allow a distribution to unsecured creditors.

6 Liquidator's Remuneration

- Creditors will note from my last report that my time costs for the period ended 7 June 2016 totalled £256,664.85 My time costs for the period 8 June 2016 to 16 December 2016 total £2,430 as per Appendix II Therefore my cumulative time costs for the duration of my appointment total £259 094 85
- A resolution approving that my fees be drawn on a time cost basis was approved by creditors on 20 September 2011. I can advise that the sum of £95,720.88 has been drawn since my last report and that my total fees drawn for the duration of my appointment total £232,374.68. I can confirm that further category 2 disbursements of £52.80 have been incurred in respect of postage in this period. Therefore my overall category 2 disbursements to date total £7,184.53 as detailed below.

- 6 3 My solicitors, Walker Morris, have continued to provide legal advice and have been paid the sum of £117,218 85 plus VAT in this respect
- I can confirm that agents, Michael Steel & Co, have been paid the sum of £22,000 plus VAT in respect of their assistance with the valuation and sale of Company assets
- I can confirm that the sum of £500 plus VAT has been paid to KJA Kilner Johnson Accountants in respect of their assistance with the preparation of financial documents in relation to the Company's assets and liabilities

- Attached at Appendix B is an analysis, in accordance with the provisions of Statement of Insolvency Practice 9 ('SIP9') that details my time costs incurred for the aforementioned period
- A guide to Liquidators' fees and a copy of this firm's disbursements policy has previously been distributed to creditors. However, in the event a further copy is required then requests should be made by contacting this office on 01274 800 380.

7 Request for Information

- In accordance with Rule 4 49E of The Insolvency Rules 1986 a secured creditor or unsecured creditors with the concurrence of at least 5% in value of the general body of unsecured creditors are entitled to request further information relating to the Liquidator's remuneration or expenses. Such requests must be made within 21 days of receipt of this report. In the event the requesting unsecured creditor does not hold a concurrence of at least 5% an application to court may be made to obtain the necessary permission. Such applications need to be made within 21 days of receipt of this report.
- In addition to the above and in accordance with Rule 4 131 of The Insolvency Rules 1986, creditors are entitled to make a claim that the Liquidator's remuneration is or expenses are excessive. Such claims should be made in the form of an application to court no later than 8 weeks after the progress report has been received. I would also add that the complaints policy of the Practice is available on request.

8 Conclusion

Upon the filing of the relevant documents at Companies House I will B granted my release as Liquidator
