1 Introduction

I write further to my six monthly report issued on 25th March 2010 and interim progress report of 29th July in relation to the extension of the Administration period

The purpose of this report is to detail my actions and dealings together with the conduct of the administration since my last report

2 Background

The Company was incorporated on 12th December 1972 under the Companies (Northern Ireland) Order 1960

The company's registered office is C/O CavanaghKelly 38 Northland Row Dungannon Co Tyrone BT71 6AP

The company's former registered office was Brookeborough Road Lisnaskea Fermanagh BT92 0LD. This was also the former trading address

The company's principal activity was boat building and marine engineering. The company traded for more than 36 years

The objective of the administration is to achieve a better result for the creditors of the Company as a whole than would be likely if the company were wound up (without first being in administration)

The administrator will at some later stage arrange for the Company to exit from the administration Based on the information presently available it is likely that the Company will be dissolved once the administration is complete

The main cause of failure of the company was significant cashflow difficulties as a result of a combination of factors including

- Significant expenditure on the development and redesign of the ISIS boat. Whilst I have been unable to confirm the exact level of expenditure to date on the ISIS project development the Directors have advised me that such costs were in the region of £800 000.
- Current market conditions as a result of the recession

3 Asset Realisations

- 3 1 As previously stated an offer had been made for £100 000 for the ISIS project and connected assets to be paid on 31st October 2010. This over has since been rescinded and I have now accepted an offer of £7 000 for the remaining assets.
- 3 2 As this offer had no bearing on the outcome for unsecured creditors i requested confirmation from the secured charge holder that they were willing to accept this offer. This has now been agreed

4 Creditors Claims

4 1 Secured Creditors

Ulster Bank Ltd is the only secured creditor of the company. The amount claimed is £582 436 55

4 2 Preferential Creditors

A preferential claim totalling £741 42 has been received from the Department of Employment and Learning in relation to redundancy payments. This will be paid in full ahead of the floating chargeholder.

4 3 Unsecured Creditors

I continue to receive claims from unsecured creditors

5 Dividend Prospects

5 1 As stated in my proposals. I do not believe any distribution will be available for unsecured creditors

- 7 2 The time costs of CavanaghKelly are analysed at Appendix II To date fees of £34 000 plus outlays totalling £2 490 49 have been drawn. Expenses incurred by the Administrator in addition to the re charged outlays included security costs for the safeguarding of all stock and assets of £10 608. I currently have unbilled time of £2 874 60.
