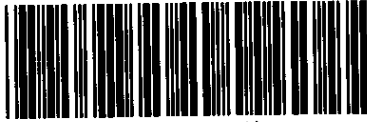



OSCR has granted an application from this charitable company to allow it to convert into a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation (SCIO). The conversion will take place shortly, following the company's registration being completed with the Registrar of Companies (Companies House).

Object:

3.1 The company's objects are: 3.1.1 To advance the arts, particularly those associated with Scottish culture; 3.1.2 To advance education and provide and/or promote training, particularly in relation to skills associated with Scottish cultural, recreational and sporting activities. 3.1.3 To provide recreational facilities and organise recreational activities, with such facilities/activities being available to members of the public at large with the object of improving their conditions of life. 3.1.4 To advance public participation in sport. 3.1.5 To advance community development. 3.1.6 To promote, establish, operate and/or support other similar schemes, which further Charitable Purposes, for the benefit of the community within the Cowan Peninsula.

Charity Accounts and Constitutions

From April 2016 we began to publish charities' accounts, initially for those charities with an annual income of £25,000 or more, and for all SCIOs.

When a charity publishes its accounts on its website and has supplied us with a link, we have made this available. From late 2017, where the charity is a company, a registered social landlord or is also registered with the Charity Commission for England and Wales, a link is provided to the relevant
