COMPANY LIQUIDATION - WINDING UP ORDER

Sheriff Caldwell

The sheriff, having resumed consideration of the foregoing petition together with the productions produced, and having seen the Edinburgh Gazette dated 26 October 2018 and the Falkirk Herald newspaper dated 25 October each containing the intimation ordered by the preceding interlocutor, no answers to said petition having been lodged in court, Finds (1) that the amount of the share capital of the said Nevis Utilities Limited paid up or credited as paid up does not exceed £120,000; (2) that the said company is unable to pay its debts;

therefore Orders that the said company, having its registered office at 20 Meeks Road, Falkirk, Stirlingshire, FK2 7ES be wound up in pursuance of the Insolvency Act, 1986; Nominates and Appoints Penny McCoull, Glenshead House, Port of Menteith, Stirling FK8 3LE to be the interim liquidator of the said company with the usual powers, all in terms of said Statute and of Law; Finds the petitioner entitled to the expenses of this application and Directs same to be expenses in the liquidation.
